

Think ahead – be prepared

Download the UQ SafeZone app which connects you directly to UQ Security for immediate on-campus emergency or first-aid support 24/7 and live GPS feed of Safety bus locations campuses.uq.edu.au/security

- Know your public transport timetables to avoid long waits, especially if you're on your own.
- Avoid waiting inside lonely, closed-in shelters. Keep to open, populated areas in full view of bus or train.
- If someone follows you, go to a place where there are other people.
- Avoid lonely or gloomy places, especially at night. Walk with a friend, a Safety Escort or stay with a crowd.
- Be wary of strangers asking directions – it's better to be rude than to be in trouble.
- Respect your intuition. Don't allow rationality to override your "sixth sense", which could protect you from danger.
- Walk confidently and stay alert. Be prepared to defend your self with the bag, keys or umbrella you're carrying, and have your car keys ready to open the car door as soon as you reach it.
- Move your car closer when you plan to be on the St Lucia campus after dark. After 5pm each weekday afternoon, Staff Permits and valid casual parking sessions authorise the holder to move their vehicles to either 1½ P, 14P Hourly and 14P Daily parking zones or Service & Maintenance bays/zones without paying an extra fee – unless otherwise signed.
- Carry your mobile phone, change or a phone card in case you need to call a taxi, friend or family member. Use the freecall number 1800 800 123. Program speed dial to 336 53333 – to be used for emergencies only.
- If you're using a public phone, turn your back to the phone after dialling and speak looking outwards.

Emergency Call Points

If you're in trouble on the St Lucia campus use an Emergency Call Point for an immediate response from Security.

At UQ Gatton, use a Security Call Point to speak directly to Security.

Walk with a Safety Escort

At night on the St Lucia, UQ Gatton campus, ask a Safety Escort to walk with you to public transport or your car.

This free service can be organised through Security (phone 3365 1234 or 1800 800 123)

Step out in safety

Some paths and roads on campus, like anywhere else, are safer than others – especially at night.

Keep to well-lit, well-used, security-patrolled paths like those on the map overleaf.

Download the UQ SafeZone app

UQ SafeZone is a free smartphone app that connects staff and students with Security and emergency services during a first-aid or emergency situation on UQ campuses and sites

UQ SafeZone allows you to make an emergency call to Security and instantly gives them your location. You can also make first-aid calls for medical attention and calls for general help such as finding your way.

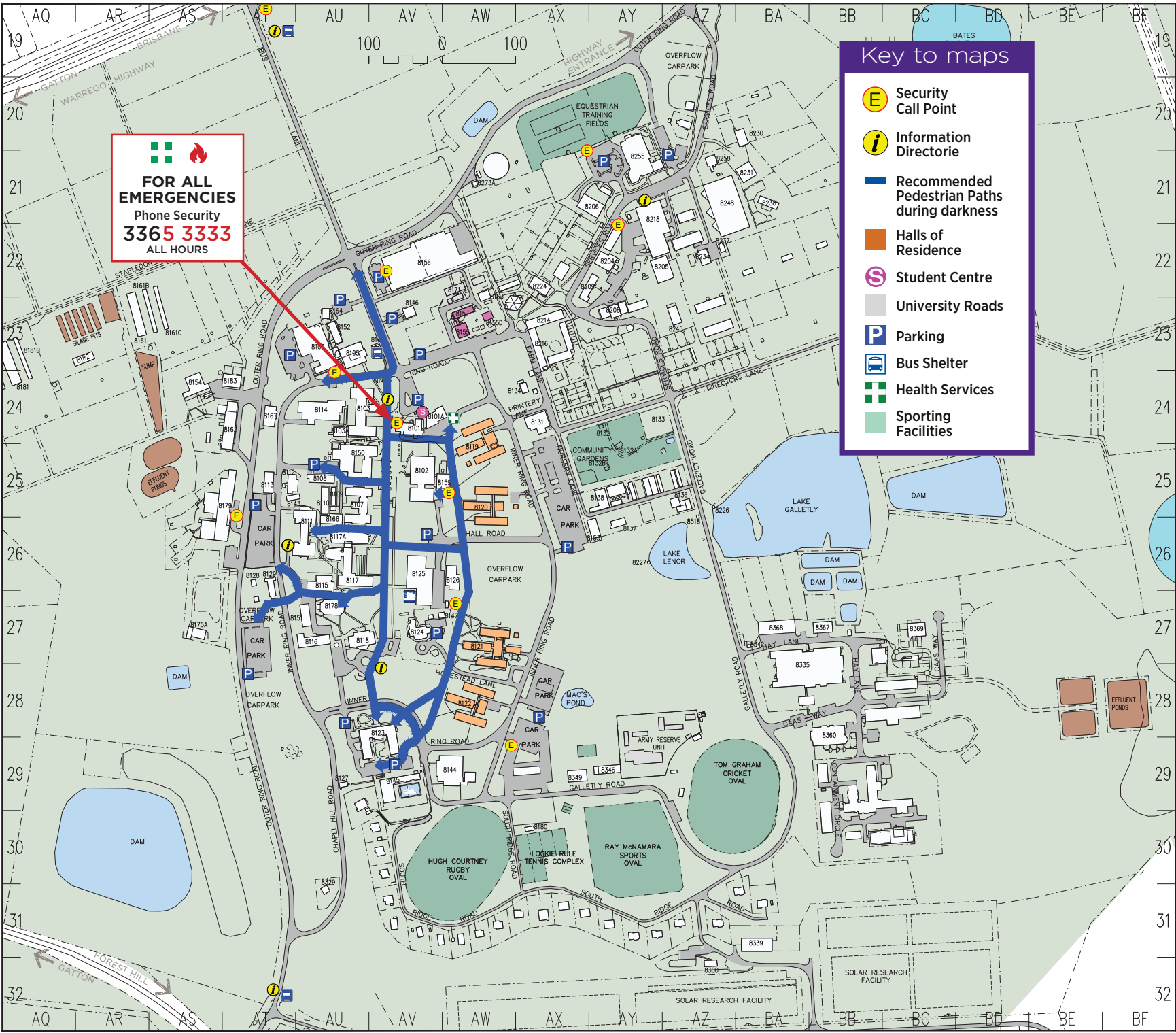
