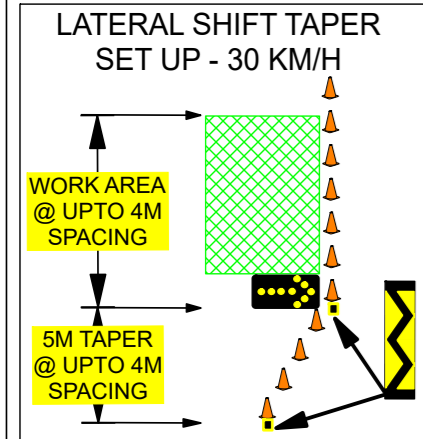
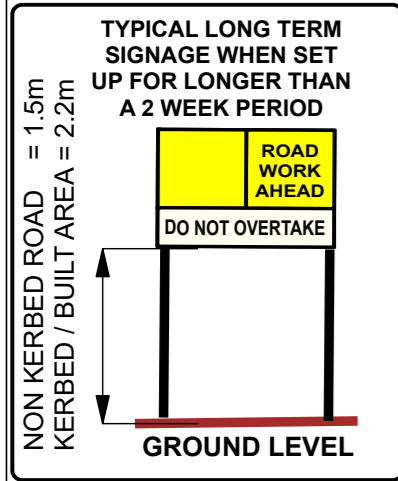
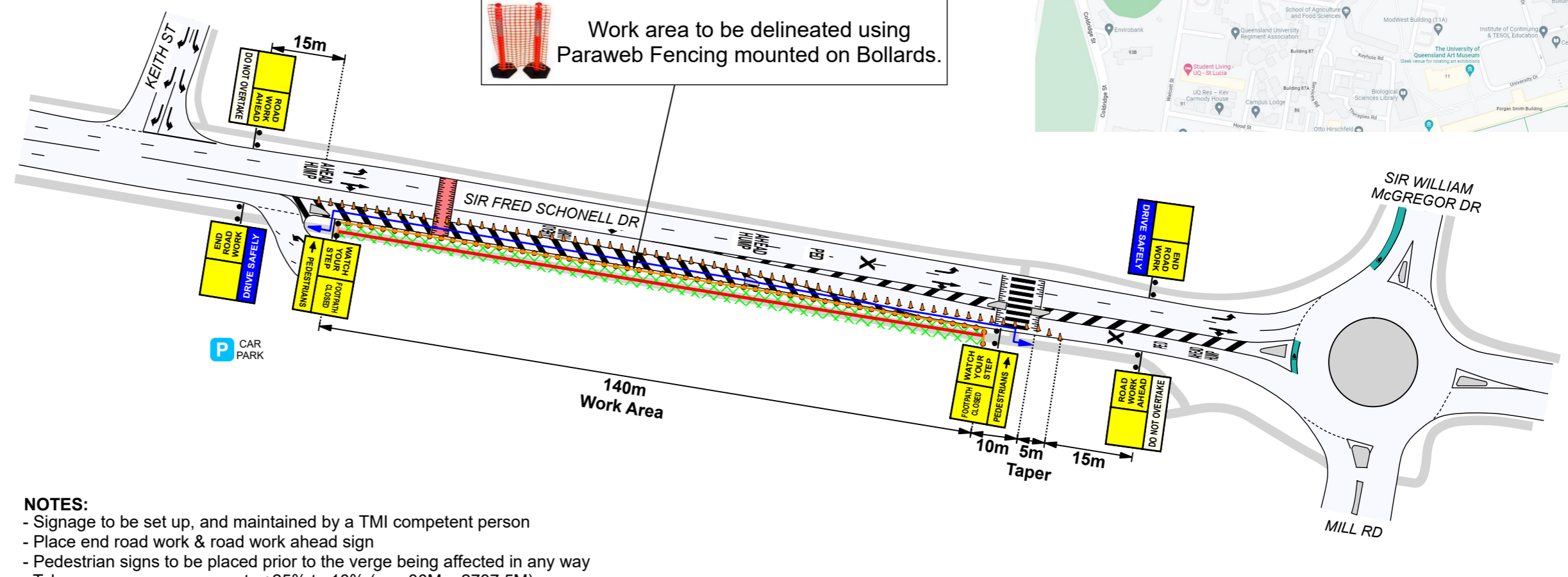
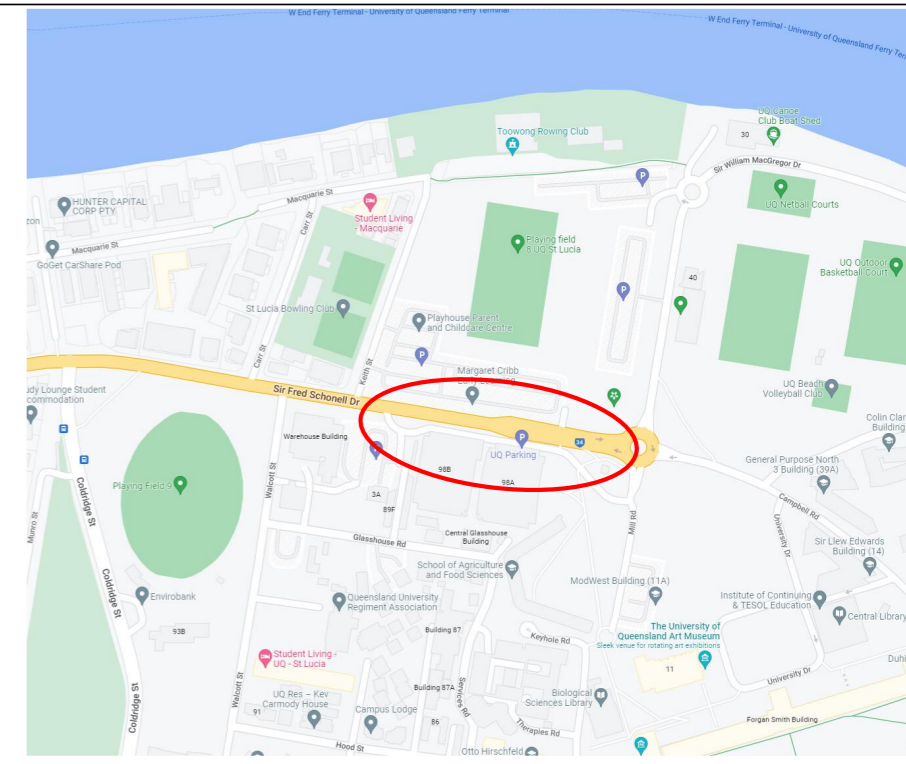
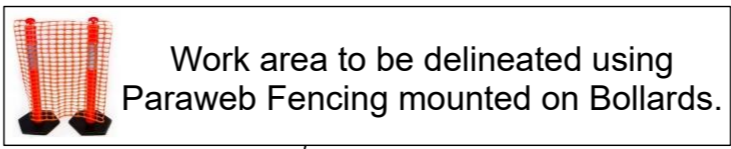


TGS works in conjunction with Notes and Risk assessment

THE MINIMUM LANE WIDTHS INCLUDING TRAFFICABLE SHOULDER SHALL BE 3.0 M (AGTTM03-21 Clause 2.5.8).



- NOTES:**
- Signage to be set up, and maintained by a TMI competent person
 - Place end road work & road work ahead sign
 - Pedestrian signs to be placed prior to the verge being affected in any way
 - Tolerances on measurements +25% to 10% (e.g. 30M = 2737.5M)
 - Minimum usable lane width for access past site to be maintained as 3m on roads with a curve of 250m or more radius, 3.5m on roads with a curve of less than 250m radius, allow for long vehicle swept path on curves of less than 100m radius
 - Minimum 2.5m edge clearance to be maintained at all times from any open longitudinal excavation deeper than 0.5m, with a close delineation of 4m spacing
 - Tapers are to be placed with the flow of traffic at all times, and in order as not to cause confusion
 - Eastbound taper to be set up from the western end, continuing east
 - Westbound taper to be set up from the eastern end, continuing west
 - Pack up to be done in reverse order.

Shoulder and Footpath to be closed during afterhours. Pedestrians to past the work area through the closed portion of the road
